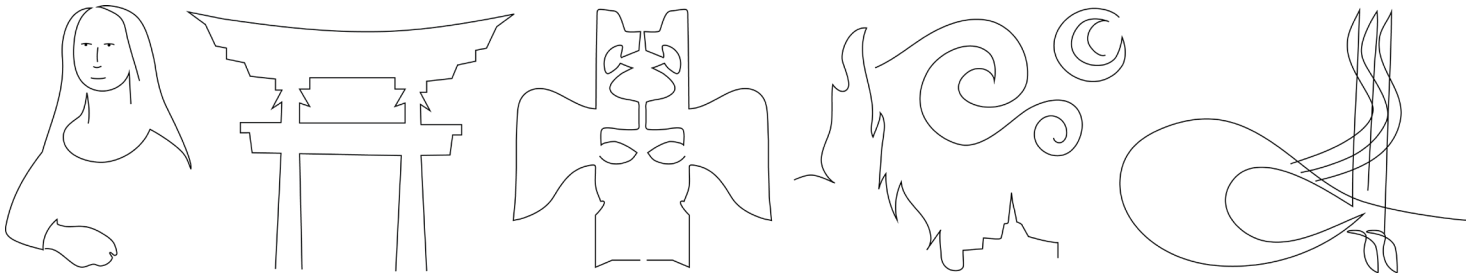

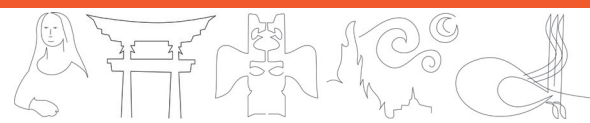

INSTRUCTIONS:

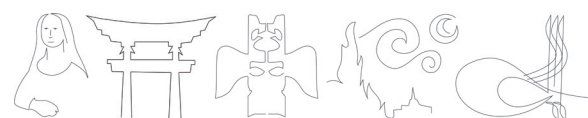
Print the printable (with color ink preferably) and give it to the student. Ask student to draw the scene around it.

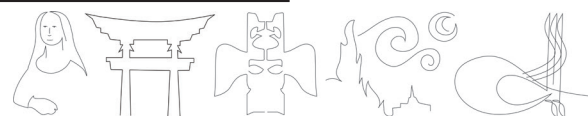

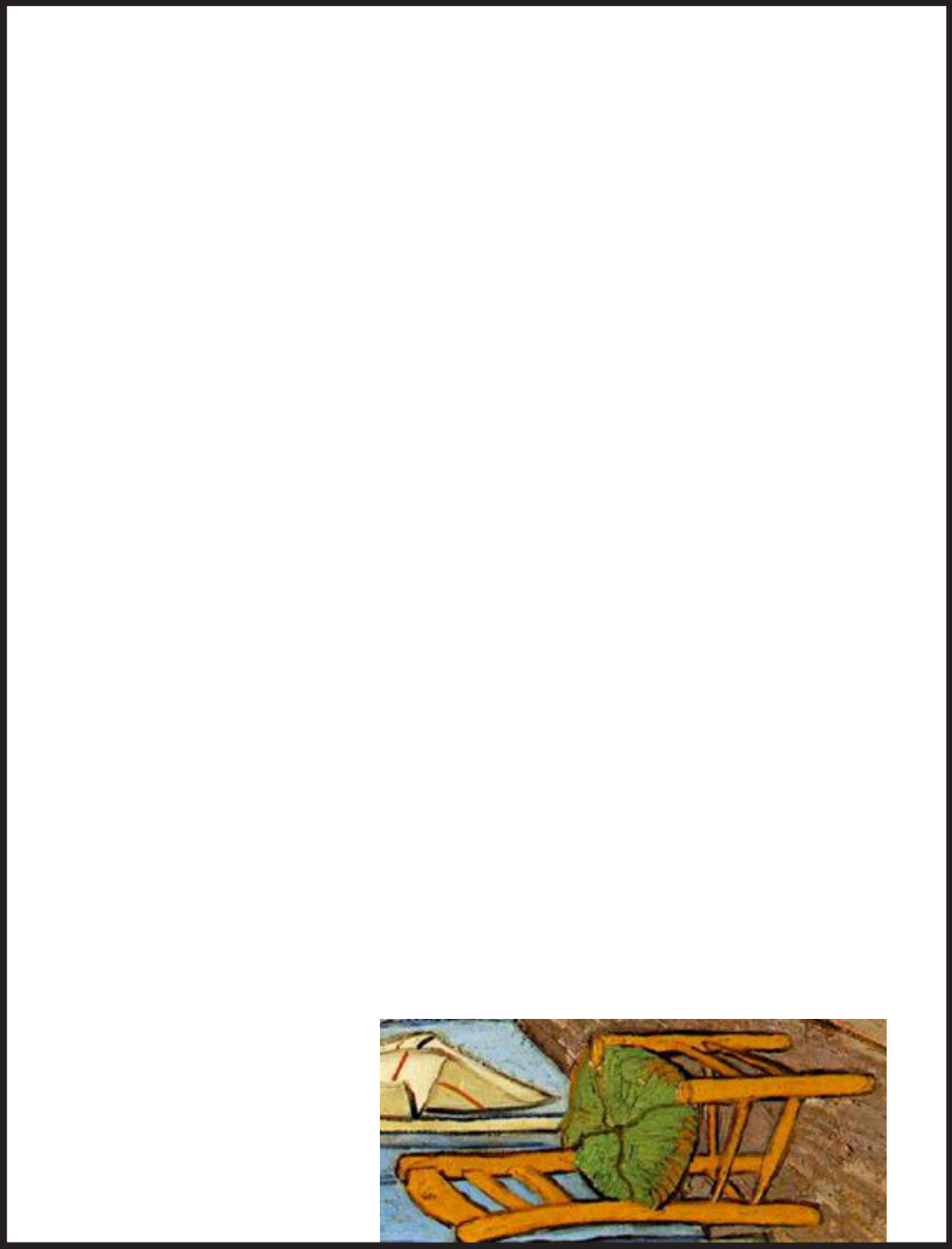

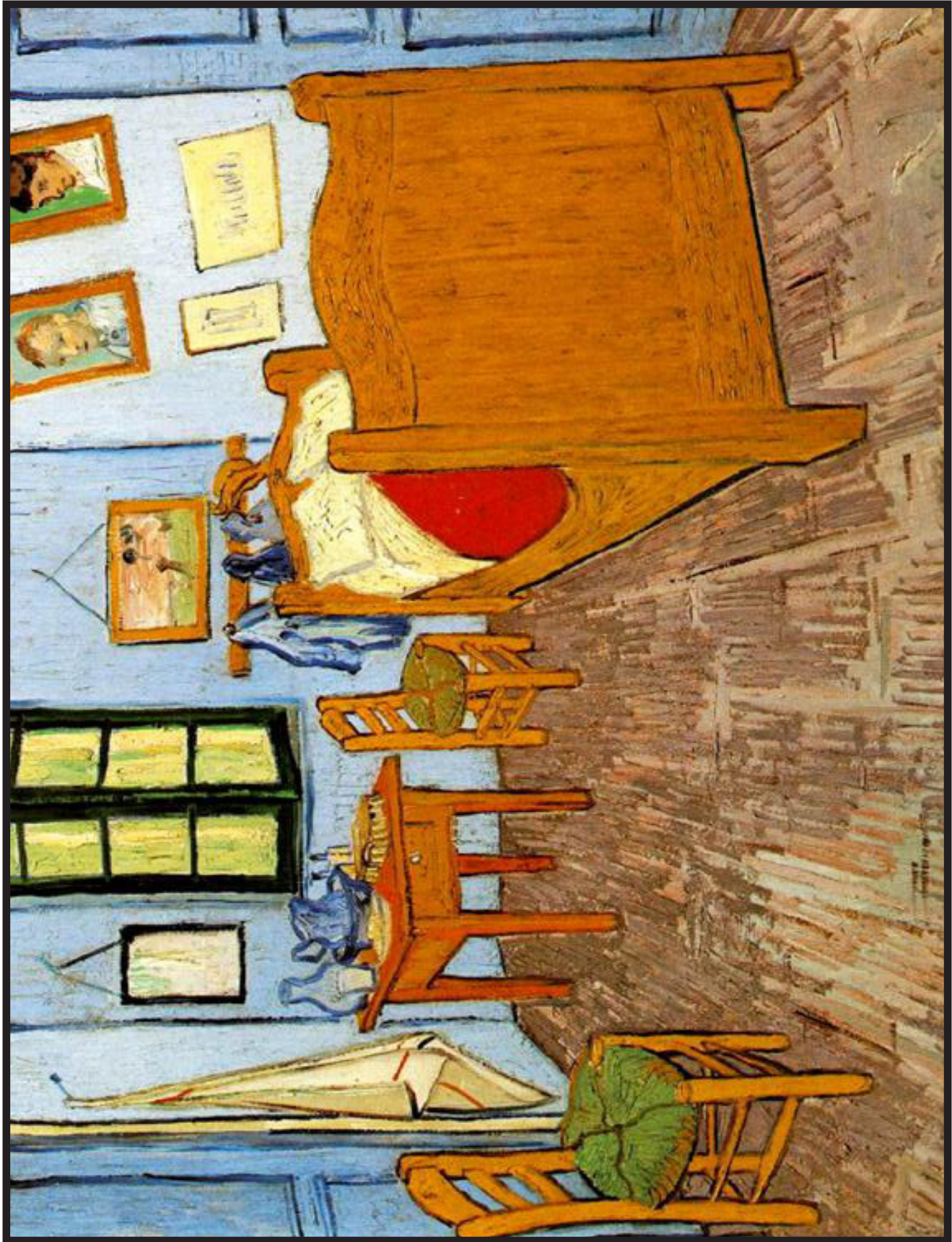

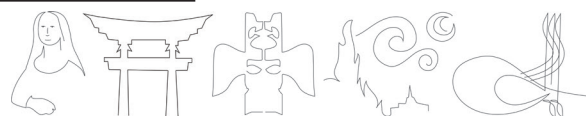

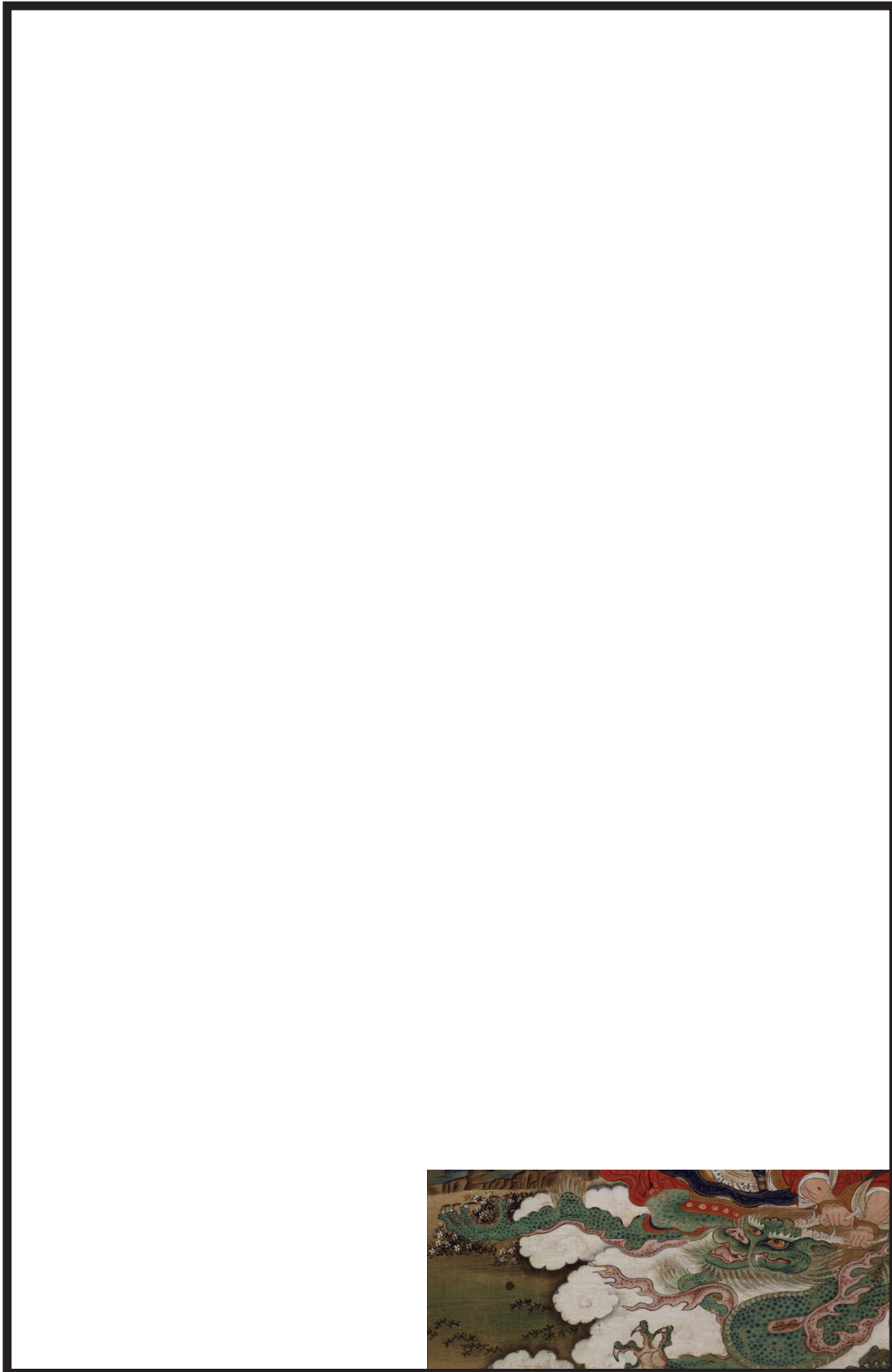
